2018-2019 FISCAL YEAR.

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Amendment No. \_\_\_ to Senate Bill No. 75

Amend Senate Bill No. 75 as originally introduced:

Insert additional section immediately following SECTION 46 of the bill to read as follows:

" SECTION 47. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. ADDITIONAL DISPROPORTIONATE SHARE PAYMENT - OLMSTEAD FEE PAYMENT RESTRICTION. Funds appropriated by this Act, fund balances or any funding sources of the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences shall not be utilized to pay, reimburse, pay administrative charges or pay any fees to another State agency for the State's Olmstead plan or for any State agency's processing or administration of State match funds received as reimbursement funding for federal financial participation under the Medicaid's Disproportionate Share (DSH) reimbursement program.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect from July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019."

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established  
23 for the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences for the 2018-2019 fiscal  
24 year, the following maximum number of regular employees.

1 these funds are to be provided to the Child Safety Centers through contracts  
2 from the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences. The contracts will  
3 stipulate the terms of the agreement and reporting requirements; an amount  
4 not to exceed fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) may be utilized for  
5 administrative costs as may be necessary to administer the program or if  
6 determined not to be needed for administrative costs may be placed in reserve  
7 for future needs of the program. The remaining two hundred thousand dollars  
8 (\$200,000) shall be allocated and made available to the Department of  
9 Pediatrics for expenses for medical examinations, consultation, education and  
10 training as stipulated in the terms of agreement between the Chancellor of  
11 the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences and the Department of  
12 Pediatrics.

13 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2017~~  
14 2018 through June 30, ~~2018~~ 2019.

16 → SECTION 47. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
17 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
18 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
19 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
20 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
21 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures  
22 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this  
23 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of  
24 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied  
25 with in disbursement of said funds.

27 SECTION 48. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
28 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
29 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
30 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
31 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
32 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
33 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
34 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

36 SECTION 49. EFFECTIVE DATE. This act is effective on and after July 1,
