1 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
2 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FORMULA
3 COMPUTATIONS - 1890 MATCHING FUNDS. Any computations made by the Department
4 of Higher Education and the Arkansas Higher Education Coordinating Board in
5 determining levels of recommended funding for the University of Arkansas at
6 Pine Bluff shall include 100% matching funds for the 1890 Research and
7 Extension Programs in the base.

9 SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
10 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SPECIAL
11 ALLOWANCES. For the purpose of providing necessary allowances for housing and
12 other unusual expenses incurred by or in behalf of the athletic director,
13 associate/assistant athletic directors, head coaches, and assistant coaches
14 at the University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff, the Board of Trustees may make
15 special allowances available therefore in such amounts as the Board of
16 Trustees may determine as justified, an equitable allowance in view of the
17 unusual and exacting duties of said athletic director, associate/assistant
18 athletic directors, head coaches, and assistant coaches, and for the purpose
19 of providing such allowances, the Board of Trustees is authorized to expend
20 from the auxiliary income of the University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff, which
21 is derived from athletic event receipts, an amount not to exceed twenty
22 thousand dollars (\$20,000) in the aggregate for such purposes during each
23 fiscal year for the athletic director and head coaches, and ten thousand
24 dollars (\$10,000) in the aggregate for such purposes during each fiscal year
25 for the associate/assistant athletic directors and assistant coaches.
26 Provided that any such allowances shall be in addition to the regular salary
27 of such athletic director, associate/assistant athletic directors, head
28 coaches and assistant coaches, as established herein provided that the amount
29 of such allowance shall not exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) per annum
30 for any one salaried position. Further, if the special allowance funds
31 authorized herein are utilized the University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff shall
32 report annually to the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee the exact
33 disposition of those special allowance funds.

34 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2013
35 through June 30, 2014.
