25 exemptions to licensure by the Veterinary Medical Examining Board, is amended
26 to read as follows:

27 (10) ~~Any~~ A chiropractor licensed in this state and certified by
28 the American Veterinary Chiropractic Association from performing chiropractic
29 upon animals ~~so long as the chiropractic is performed under the immediate~~
