Re: Request to be excluded from the rule reporting requirements of Act 595 of 2021 with respect to Act 746 of 2021

Dear Senator Hammer and Representative Eaves;

As you know, Ark. Code Ann. § 25-15-216(b)(3)-(5), as amended by Act 595 of 2021, established certain reporting requirements for state agencies, including a written update on the agency's progress in promulgating rules. Act 746 of 2021 provides that an occupational or professional licensing entity shall grant a license to an individual who fulfills the requirements to practice and who holds a Federal Form I-766 from the US Citizenship and Immigration Service. Act 746 of 2021, § 2, further provides that all licensing entities "shall promulgate rules necessary to implement this act."

Pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 25-15-216(c), as amended by Act 595 of 2021, the department does not intend to promulgate any rules to implement Act 746 of 2021, as it is not necessary. Such a rule would merely restate the provisions of Act 746 of 2021. Further, none of the department's licensing entities have any rule or statute, such as a citizenship requirement. As a result, the department respectfully requests that any rulemaking regarding Act 746 of 2021 be excluded from further reporting requirements.
