## Re: Act 595 Monthly Written Updates

Dear Jessica:

This serves as the Arkansas Ethics Commission's ("AEC") monthly Act 595 Report.

As reflected in the previous report, legislation passed during the 93rd General Assembly has necessitated that the AEC amend the following three (3) sets of existing rules:

1. Rules on Political Committees;
2. Rules on Campaign Finance & Disclosure; and
3. Rules on Campaign Contribution Limit.

The third set of Rules, i.e., the Rules on Campaign Contribution Limit, has already been amended to reflect the changes made by **Act 384**. The amended set of Rules became effective on August 5, 2021.

The AEC approved amended sets of Rules on Political Committees and Rules on Campaign Finance & Disclosure at a public hearing held at 9:00 a.m. on November 19, 2021. The AEC did not receive any public comments, but did incorporate one (1) technical correction received from the Bureau of Legislative Research.
