Repeal: The Arkansas GIS Board (A.C.A. § 15-21-504) intends to repeal this rule because it is out of date with current technology and data collection methods. When this rule was adopted in 2001, in-field GPS data collection with mapping grade systems was much more common for collecting features such as road centerlines or physical address points and guidance was appropriate. Currently, the preferred mapping method is to use high resolution aerial imagery which is much more available than in the early 2000s.
