

Thoroughbred Rule 1245 Amendment Summary

This amendment allows horses to be disqualified for the remainder of the calendar year rather than through the end of the Oaklawn meet in May of each year. In the past, a horse could violate a Rule near the end of the meet and be suspended for only a few days, until the end of the meet. Under this amendment, a horse can be suspended until December 31 of each year.

Thoroughbred Rule 1245 Mark Up

1245. Any horse that has been the subject of a fraudulent practice or other violation of the Rules may be disqualified by the Stewards for no longer period than the remainder of the calendar year.
