

Thoroughbred Rule 2162 Amendment Summary

This amendment prohibits advertising on jockeys' attire without the consent of the owner, the Stewards and the franchise holder.

Thoroughbred Rule 2162 Mark Up

2162. In riding a race, a jockey must be neat in appearance and must wear conventional attire and the racing colors of the owner or owners of the horse the jockey is riding. No advertising on the jockey's attire is permitted without the approval of the stewards, owner and the Franchise Holder.
