

Thoroughbred Rule 2281 Amendment Summary

This amendment provides a procedure for selecting entries when more than 12 horses enter a race.

Thoroughbred Rule 2281 Mark Up

2281--If more than twelve (12) horses are entered for any purse race, a list of names not to exceed six (6) may be drawn in order of preference from the overflow entries and listed as eligible to start, if originally carded horse or horses are excused from the race. ~~A new drawing shall be taken from all horses on the also-eligible list, and their order of eligibility and post positions shall be determined by the sequence in which they are drawn.~~ The owner or trainer of any horse on the also-eligible list shall, if he does not intend to start, so notify the Racing Secretary not later than scratch time.
