The purpose of the job is to provide epidemiological support to two programs at ADH: the newly created prescription Monitoring Program (PMP), and the Tick-Borne Disease (TBD) program within the Analytical Epidemiology Branch. Under the PMP, the epidemiologist is responsible for the study and evaluation of prescription drug use patterns and trends and assists in evaluation of the state wide PMP. Under the Tick-Borne Disease program, the epidemiologist will investigate suspect TBD reports, develop training plans and deliver training, and participate in data analysis and development of quarterly and year-end summary reports for TBD.
