3 REQUESTING THAT THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON JUDICIARY STUDY AND  
4 DEVELOP RULES AND PROCEDURES FOR THE IMPEACHMENT PROCESS IN THE  
5 STATE OF ARKANSAS.

7 WHEREAS, Arkansas Constitution Article 15, § 2, states that all  
8 impeachments shall be tried by the Senate; and

9  
10 WHEREAS, the General Assembly has codified limited procedures for the  
11 impeachment process in § 21-12-201 et seq.; and

12  
13 WHEREAS, while impeachment is occasionally referenced as a possible  
14 option when considering alleged misconduct by elected officials, the Senate  
15 lacks procedural rules to conduct an impeachment trial; and

16  
17 WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the Senate to review the laws  
18 and history addressing the impeachment process and consider necessary rules  
19 and procedures for the effective conduct of impeachment trials within its  
20 chamber; and

21  
22 WHEREAS, it would be beneficial to study the processes for impeachment  
23 used by other states and the United States Government to ensure the rules,  
24 procedures, and processes are similar,

26 NOW THEREFORE,

27 BE IT PROPOSED BY THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON JUDICIARY OF THE NINETY-FIRST  
28 GENERAL ASSEMBLY:

29  
30 THAT the Senate Committee on Judiciary study the impeachment process  
31 envisioned by the Arkansas Constitution and the Arkansas Code, study the  
32 impeachment process used by other states and the United States Government,  
33 and consider rules and procedures necessary for the conduct of impeachment  
34 trials.
