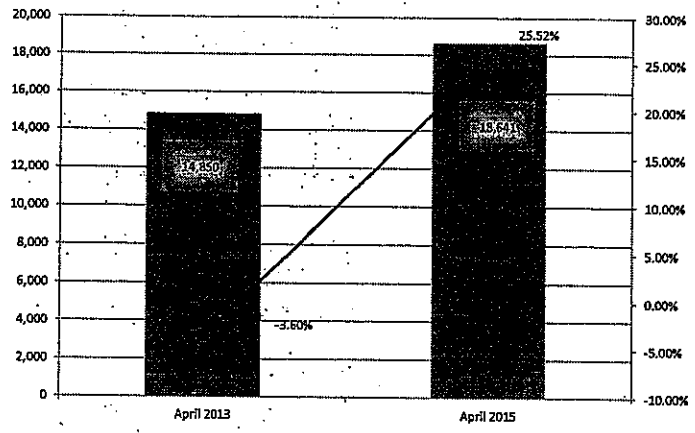


Arkansas' prison population has grown 32.69% since 2004 (last 10 years)

Number of probation revocations sent to prison last year for non-violent crimes for 2014 versus 2006

1791 probationers were revoked to ADC in 2006. Of those, a total of 865 committed a new offense and 575 (66.5%) of those were for non-violent offenses.

2115 probationers were revoked to ADC in 2014. Of those, a total of 1066 committed a new offense and 712 (66.8%) committed a new non-violent offense.
