3 REQUESTING THAT THE HOUSE COMMITTEE ON STATE AGENCIES AND  
4 GOVERNMENTAL AFFAIRS CONDUCT A STUDY OF THE MOST COST-EFFICIENT  
5 AND COST-EFFECTIVE USES OF THE SPACE WITHIN THE STATE CAPITOL  
6 BUILDING.

8 WHEREAS, the Arkansas State Capitol is a historic building, the seat of  
9 state government, and a tourist attraction for the State of Arkansas; and

11 WHEREAS, to best achieve the diverse functions served by the State  
12 Capitol Building and to maximize its benefits to the State of Arkansas, a  
13 study of the most cost-efficient and cost-effective uses of all space within  
14 the State Capitol Building should be conducted, and all occupants and  
15 affected state agencies and constitutional officers should cooperate and  
16 assist in the study for the benefit of the citizens of this state,

18 NOW THEREFORE,

19 BE IT PROPOSED BY THE HOUSE COMMITTEE ON STATE AGENCIES AND GOVERNMENTAL  
20 AFFAIRS OF THE 88TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 THAT the interim House Committee on State Agencies and Governmental  
23 Affairs conduct a comprehensive study of the most cost-efficient and cost-  
24 effective use of the space within the State Capitol Building and that all  
25 occupants and affected state agencies and constitutional officers fully  
26 cooperate and assist the House Committee on State Agencies and Governmental  
27 Affairs with this study.
