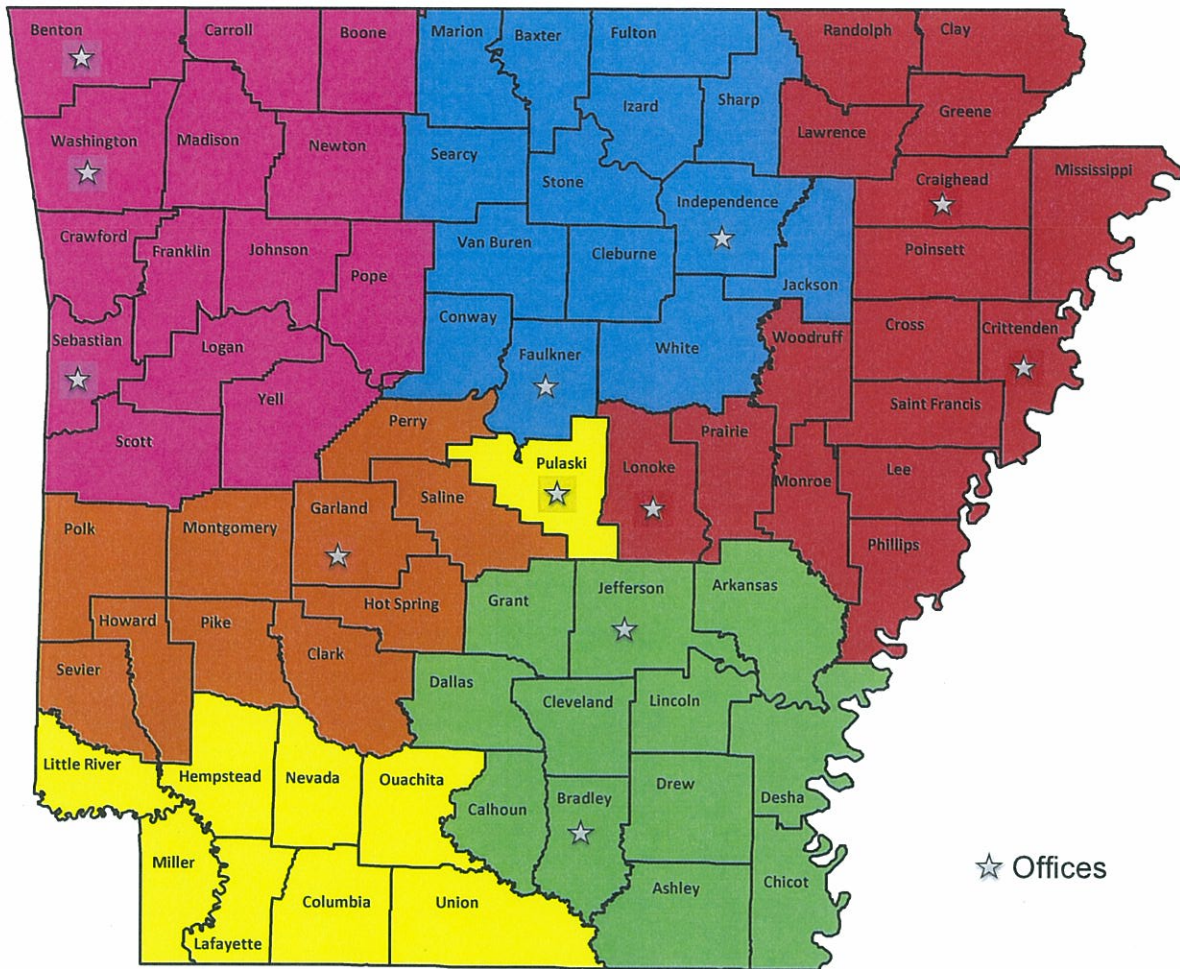

- Delivery of resource center materials twice monthly to facilities in the Batesville, Cedar Ridge and Southside School Districts during the regular school year. (These school districts financially support this project)
- A Child Care Resource Center located in Batesville and is available to child care providers and early childhood students during regular business hours year round to all counties we serve.
