17 TO PROVIDE FOR ARKANSAS AGRITOURISM SIGNS
18 AT STATE WELCOME CENTERS AND TOURIST
19 INFORMATION CENTERS THROUGH THE ARKANSAS
20 WINE COUNTRY TRAILS PROGRAM.

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

25 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-67-224, concerning the Arkansas Wine
26 Country Trail, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:

27 (c)(1) The Department of Parks and Tourism and the Arkansas State
28 Highway and Transportation Department, in conjunction with the Arkansas Wine
29 Producers Council, shall develop and install signs to promote Arkansas
30 agritourism, incorporating Arkansas Wine Country Trail symbols, to be
31 installed:

32 (A) On the main thoroughfare approaching welcome centers
33 or tourist information centers within one (1) mile of the entrance to welcome
34 centers or tourist information centers; or

35 (B) If installation on approach is not feasible, then on
36 the main thoroughfare within one (1) mile past the entrance to welcome

1 centers and tourist information centers or, if no feasible space exists in
2 that mile, then as soon after that mile as possible.

3 (2) The signs shall be:

4 (A) A minimum of twelve feet by forty-eight feet (12' x
5 48'); and

6 (B) Constructed from:

7 (i) Steel; or

8 (ii) Treated lumber and recycled utility poles.
