

INTERIM STUDY PROPOSAL 2017-083

REQUESTING THAT THE HOUSE COMMITTEE ON STATE AGENCIES AND GOVERNMENTAL AFFAIRS STUDY THE IMPACT OF PROVIDING A PARTIAL PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTION FOR VETERANS WHO HAVE LESS THAN A ONE HUNDRED PERCENT TOTAL AND PERMANENT DISABILITY.

WHEREAS, Arkansas values the service of military veterans; and

WHEREAS, Arkansas wants to support veterans and encourage them to stay in, return to, or relocate to Arkansas; and

WHEREAS, Arkansas currently provides a total property tax exemption only for veterans who have a one hundred percent total and permanent disability; and

WHEREAS, it would show the state's support and would encourage more veterans to stay in, return to, or relocate to Arkansas if the state offered a partial property tax exemption for veterans who have less than a one hundred percent total and permanent disability,

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT PROPOSED BY THE HOUSE COMMITTEE ON STATE AGENCIES AND GOVERNMENTAL AFFAIRS OF THE NINETY-FIRST GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

THAT the House Committee on State Agencies and Governmental Affairs study the impact of providing a partial property tax exemption for veterans who have less than a one hundred percent total and permanent disability.
