**I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES:**

**MISSION**

The Arkansas Appraiser Licensing and Certification Board maintains a system for licensing and regulating state registered, licensed, and certified appraisers in Arkansas, assuring license holders have adequate education, experience and competency necessary to provide service consistent with their credentials. The board also investigates complaints concerning real estate appraisers in Arkansas.

**TOTAL APPROPRIATION**

The total appropriation is \$476,803.

**FUNDING SOURCE**

The Appraiser Licensing Board is cash funded, with income generated from the receipt of application fees and annual license renewals.

**II) CHANGE LEVEL REQUESTS**

**Cash Operations**

This appropriation includes a total change level increase of \$36,100 for the following:

- Operating Expenses - Increase of \$16,100, \$14,000 for an increase in the national registry fee required by the Appraisal Subcommittee and \$2,100 for website maintenance.
- Conference and Travel - Increase of \$20,000 for sponsorship of the annual continuing education seminar for Arkansas real property appraisers.
