I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES

MISSION

The Contract Licensing Board exists to preserve public health and safety in the construction industry in Arkansas. Responsibilities include determining qualifications of applicants for contractor's licenses and authorizing the issuance of new and renewal licenses, investigating all alleged and factual violations of the Contractor's Licensing Law, the Contractor's Bond Law, and the Residential Licensing Law, as well as hold hearings and the assessment of penalties to ensure compliance.

TOTAL APPROPRIATION

The total appropriation for FY2018 is \$1,832,683.

FUNDING SOURCES

The Contractors Licensing Board is funded from the receipt of fees charged for examination, issuance and renewal of commercial and residential contractor's licenses and penalties associated with violations of regulations.

II) CHANGE LEVEL REQUESTS

OPERATIONS

This appropriation is funded from the receipt of fees charged for examination, issuance, and renewal of commercial contractor's licenses and penalties. The appropriation totals \$1,832,683 and decreases \$93,259 in the Regular Salaries and Personal Services Matching line items for the elimination of one Licensing Coordinator position and one Administrative Specialist III position.
