26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

28 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-92-101(16)(A)(i)(d), concerning the
29 definition of "practice of pharmacy", is amended to read as follows:

30 (d) Vaccines and immunizations other than
31 influenza vaccines and influenza immunizations may be administered to a
32 person from seven (7) years of age to eighteen (18) years of age under a
33 ~~patient specific order or prescription~~ general written protocol and subject
34 to reporting of the administration to the prescribing physician together with
35 any reporting required under § 20-15-1203.
