22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
23

24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 12-12-1010 is amended to read as follows:
25 "12-12-1010. Dissemination for other purposes.

26 (a) Criminal history information shall be made available to the office
27 of the Governor for purposes of carrying out the Governor's constitutional
28 authority involving pardons, executive clemencies, extraditions, or other
29 duties specifically authorized by law.

30 (b) Criminal history information may be made available to persons
31 performing research related to the administration of criminal justice, subject
32 to conditions approved by the central repository or the Identification Bureau
33 to assure the security of the information and the privacy of individuals to
34 whom the information relates.

35 (c) Criminal history information may be made available to private
36 contractors providing penitentiary services to a governmental criminal justice

1 agency, pursuant to a specific agreement approved by the Arkansas Crime
2 Information Center which limits the use of the information to the purposes for
3 which given, to ensure the security and confidentiality of the information.

4 (d) Criminal history information shall be made available according to
5 the provisions of the ~~Interstate Compact on the Exchange of Criminal History~~
6 ~~Records for Noncriminal Justice Purposes~~ National Crime Prevention and Privacy
7 Compact following the adoption of such compact by the General Assembly.”

8
9 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
10 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
11 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

12
13 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
14 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
15 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
16 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
17 act are declared to be severable.

18
19 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
20 hereby repealed.
