## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 13-5-502 PERTAINING TO  
10 MUSEUM COMMISSIONERS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

### Subtitle

13 "TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 13-5-502  
14 PERTAINING TO MUSEUM COMMISSIONERS."

15  
16  
17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

18  
19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 13-5-502(a) and (b) are amended to read as  
20 follows:

21 "(a) In those counties in which the quorum court shall elect to  
22 establish a county museum under the provisions of this subchapter, the museum  
23 shall be under the direct management and control of a county museum  
24 commission, which shall consist of ~~seven (7)~~ three (3), six (6), or nine (9)  
25 members to be appointed by the county judge, subject to confirmation and  
26 approval of the quorum court. The size of the commission shall be determined  
27 by the quorum court, in collaboration with the museum director and the  
28 chairman of the commission if they exist at the time of the determination.  
29 The determination of size shall be made considering the size of the museum and  
30 the population of the county.

31 (b) The county judge shall specify, at the time of appointment, the  
32 respective terms of the first members appointed to the county museum  
33 commission in such a manner that the term of one (1), two (2) or three (3)  
34 member(s) shall expire on January 1 of the year next following the appointment  
35 of that member and the remaining members shall be appointed in such a manner  
36 that the term of one (1) member shall expire on January 1 of each year

1 thereafter. Successor members shall be appointed for ~~seven-~~ three (3) year  
2 staggered terms and shall serve until their successors are appointed and  
3 qualified."

4  
5 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
6 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
7 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

8  
9 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
10 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
11 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
12 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
13 act are declared to be severable.

14  
15 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
16 hereby repealed.
