## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 5-1-102 (14) CONCERNING  
10 THE DEFINITION OF PHYSICAL INJURY FOR PURPOSES OF THE  
11 ARKANSAS CRIMINAL CODE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

13 "AN ACT CONCERNING THE DEFINITION OF  
14 PHYSICAL INJURY FOR PURPOSES OF THE  
15 ARKANSAS CRIMINAL CODE."

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
20

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 5-1-102 (14), concerning the definition of  
22 physical injury for purposes of the Arkansas Criminal Code, is amended to read  
23 as follows:

24 "(14) 'Physical injury' means the impairment of physical condition or  
25 the infliction of substantial pain or the infliction of bruising, swelling or  
26 visible marks associated with physical trauma;"  
27

28 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
29 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
30 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.  
31

32 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
33 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
34 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
35 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
36 act are declared to be severable.
