20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 12-14-104 is amended to read as follows:
23 12-14-104. Territory - Cumulative remedies.

24 This chapter shall apply to and encompass all lands, buildings, and
25 improvements which are commonly referred to as the State Capitol grounds and
26 additional areas set out in this section and that are bounded as follows:
27 ~~Beginning at the corner of Woodlane Avenue and Seventh Street, then west~~
28 ~~along Seventh Street to the Rock Island Railroad right of way, then~~
29 ~~northeasterly along the railroad right of way to Third Street, then east~~
30 ~~along Third Street to a point where Woodlane Avenue if extended would~~
31 ~~intersect Third Street, then south to and along Woodlane Avenue to the point~~
32 ~~of beginning, and all streets adjoining or traversing the State Capitol~~
33 ~~grounds.~~ Beginning at the point where the centerline of 10th Street intersects
34 the eastern edge of the right-of-way of the Missouri Pacific and Rock Island
35 Railroad Line, then northeast along the southern boundary of that right-of-
36 way to the point where the centerline of Cross Street, extended northeast,

1 intersects that right-of-way, then south along the centerline of Cross Street
2 to the point where that line intersects the northern edge of the Wilbur Mills
3 Freeway, surveyed by the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation
4 Department, to the point of the beginning. Provided, however, nothing herein
5 shall be interpreted as in any way interfering with the ownership and control
6 which is by law now vested in the governing boards of each department as to
7 its lands, buildings, and improvements. The provisions of this chapter shall
8 be cumulative to any remedies which each such department may now possess for
9 enforcing its rules and regulations, including its rights to impose sanctions
10 through fees and charges, its right to discipline, deny service to, and to
11 expel.
