22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 6-82-503(a) is amended to read as follows:

25 (a) If any Arkansas law enforcement officer, full-time or volunteer
26 fireman, state highway employee, state correction employee, state parks
27 employee, teacher, or state forestry employee suffers fatal injuries or wounds
28 or becomes permanently and totally disabled as a result of injuries or wounds
29 which occurred in the performance of a hazardous duty within the scope of his
30 employment or which occurred en route to a location where a hazardous
31 situation existed, his children and spouse shall be entitled to ~~an eight-~~
32 ~~semester~~ a total of eight semesters, or the equivalent thereof, ~~scholarship of~~
33 scholarship awards without cost, exclusive of books, food, school supplies,
34 materials, and dues or fees for extracurricular activities, at any state-
35 supported college, ~~or university, or Technical Institute~~ of his choice within
36 this state. Up to four-semester, or the equivalent thereof, may be taken at

1 a Technical Institute.
