23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

25 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 5-14-112 is amended to read as follows:

26 5-14-112. Indecent exposure.

27 (a)(1) A person commits indecent exposure if, with purpose to arouse or
28 gratify the sexual desire of himself or of any other person, he exposes his
29 sex organs:

30 (A) In a public place or public view; or

31 (B) Under circumstances in which he knows his conduct is
32 likely to cause affront or alarm.

33 (2) Indecent exposure is a Class A misdemeanor.

34 (3)(A) If the indecent exposure is committed against a person under the
35 age of fifteen (15) years, but greater than eleven (11) years, a second or
36 subsequent offense of indecent exposure against a person under the age of

1 fifteen (15) years, but greater than eleven (11) years shall be a Class D
2 felony.

3 (B) Subdivision (a)(3)(A) shall not apply if the actor is
4 under the age of eighteen (18) years at the time of the offense.

5 (b)(1) A person commits indecent exposure to a person under the age of
6 twelve (12) years if, with the purpose to arouse or gratify the sexual desire
7 of himself or of any other person he purposefully exposes his sex organs to a
8 person under the age of twelve (12) years.

9 (2) Indecent exposure to a person under the age of twelve (12)
10 years ~~and under~~ is a Class D felony.
