25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

27 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 26-17-202 is amended to read as follows:  
28 26-17-202. Attorney Attorneys.

29 (a) The Director of the Department of Finance and Administration, if  
30 he deems necessary and if a saving of money can be had thereby, ~~by and with~~  
31 ~~the approval of the Governor,~~ shall employ an attorney one (1) or more  
32 attorneys for the Revenue Division. ~~The attorney shall have the same~~  
33 ~~qualifications as are required for a circuit judge.~~
