10 AN ACT TO ENSURE THAT TEACHERS RECEIVE A THIRTY-  
11 MINUTE UNINTERRUPTED DUTY-FREE LUNCH PERIOD  
12 DURING EACH STUDENT INSTRUCTIONAL DAY; AND FOR  
13 OTHER PURPOSES.

16 AN ACT TO ENSURE THAT TEACHERS RECEIVE A  
17 THIRTY-MINUTE UNINTERRUPTED DUTY-FREE  
18 LUNCH PERIOD DURING EACH STUDENT

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
23

24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-17-111(a), concerning teachers' duty-free  
25 lunch period during each student instructional day, is amended to read as  
26 follows:

27 (a)(1) ~~For a minimum of eighty percent (80%) of the student contact~~  
28 ~~days, each~~ Each school district in this state shall provide at least a  
29 thirty-minute uninterrupted duty-free lunch period during each student  
30 instructional day for each certified school employee in its employment.

31 (2) Any teacher not receiving a duty-free lunch ~~for a minimum of~~  
32 ~~eighty percent (80%) of the student contact days shall receive an hourly per~~  
33 ~~diem rate~~ period during each student instructional day as provided in  
34 subdivision (a)(1) of this section shall be compensated at his or her hourly  
35 rate of pay for each missed lunch period ~~unless the teacher waives his or her~~



1 ~~right to be compensated.~~

2 (3) A school district shall be exempt from the provisions of  
3 this subsection (a) if it:

4 (A) Has collectively negotiated a contract through a local  
5 teacher's association; and

6 (B) The collectively negotiated contract expressly  
7 addresses a duty-free lunch period.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall be effective beginning August 1, 2005.
