18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 19-5-944 is amended to read as follows:

21 19-5-944. County Assessors' Continuing Education Trust Fund.

22 (a)(1)(A) There is created on the books of the Treasurer of State, the
23 Auditor of State, and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State the County
24 Assessors' Continuing Education Trust Fund.

25 (B)(i) The quorum court of each county shall annually
26 appropriate and pay into the fund in the State Treasury the sum of ~~four~~
27 ~~hundred fifty dollars (\$450)~~ six hundred dollars (\$600) from fees of the
28 office of county assessor.

29 (ii) If any quorum court shall fail or refuse to
30 appropriate and pay over the funds to the trust fund in the State Treasury,
31 the Treasurer of State shall withhold funds from the county aid due to the
32 county and shall credit the funds to the trust fund.

33 (2) The trust fund shall consist of all moneys required to be
34 paid in annually as set out in this section, all interest earned from the
35 investment of fund balances, and any remaining fund balances carried forward



1 from year to year.

2 (b) The funds in the trust fund shall be used exclusively for the
3 establishment and operation of a continuing education program for county
4 assessors and for paying the meals, lodging, registration fees, and mileage
5 at the rate prescribed in state travel regulations of county assessors who
6 attend the continuing education programs.
