## For An Act To Be Entitled

10 AN ACT TO ALLOW THE ARKANSAS STATE BOARD OF  
11 PHARMACY TO WAIVE PERMIT FEES FOR PHARMACY  
12 TECHNICIANS WORKING AS VOLUNTEERS IN CHARITABLE  
13 CLINICS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

15 AN ACT TO ALLOW THE ARKANSAS STATE BOARD  
16 OF PHARMACY TO WAIVE PERMIT FEES FOR  
17 PHARMACY TECHNICIANS WORKING AS  
18 VOLUNTEERS IN CHARITABLE CLINICS.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
23

24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code §§ 17-92-108(a)(17) and 17-92-108(a)(18),  
25 concerning the license fees for pharmacy technicians, are amended to read as  
26 follows:

27 (17)(A) The fee for the original issuance of a pharmacy  
28 technician's permit shall not exceed thirty-five dollars (\$35.00).

29 (B) The fee for the renewal of a pharmacy technician's  
30 permit shall not exceed thirty-five dollars (\$35.00) per year.

31 (C) The board may waive the fees under subdivisions  
32 (a)(17)(A) and (B) of this section if the pharmacy technician performs  
33 pharmacy technician duties as a volunteer in a charitable clinic;

34 (18)(A) The reinstatement fee for a pharmacy technician's permit  
35 shall not exceed forty dollars (\$40.00).



1                   (B) The board may waive the fee under subdivision  
2 (a)(18)(A) of this section if the pharmacy technician performs pharmacy  
3 technician duties as a volunteer in a charitable clinic; and
