21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 *SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-36-102 is amended to read as follows:*

24 *5-36-102. Consolidation of offenses – Shoplifting presumption – Theft*
25 *by deception at auction of livestock presumption – Amount of theft.*

26 *(a) Conduct denominated theft in this chapter constitutes a single*
27 *offense embracing the separate offenses known before January 1, 1976, as:*

- 28 *(1) Larceny;*
- 29 *(2) Embezzlement;*
- 30 *(3) False pretense;*
- 31 *(4) Extortion;*
- 32 *(5) Blackmail;*
- 33 *(6) Fraudulent conversion;*
- 34 *(7) Receiving stolen property; and*
- 35 *(8) Other similar offenses.*
