9 AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE EIGHTY-SEVENTH SESSION
10 PROJECTS ACCOUNT WITHIN THE GENERAL IMPROVEMENT
11 FUND; TO DEFINE THE MONIES TO BE AVAILABLE IN
12 SUCH ACCOUNT; AND TO DEFINE THE PURPOSES FOR
13 WHICH MONIES MAY BE MADE AVAILABLE FROM THE
14 GENERAL IMPROVEMENT FUND SO THAT ADDITIONAL FUNDS
15 CAN BE MADE AVAILABLE FOR THE STATE BUDGET; AND
16 FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
26

27 SECTION 1. This Act may be cited as the "General Improvement Distribution
28 Act of 2009".
29

30 SECTION 2. There is hereby created and established on the books of the
31 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the State Treasurer and the State Auditor,
32 the "87th Session Projects Account" within the "General Improvement Fund",
33 into which shall be transferred and credited the respective monies as
34 hereinafter provided in this Act, to be used for providing financing, in the
35 manner set forth herein, for the various projects and purposes enumerated in



1 this Act to be financed from said account.

2 Immediately upon the effective date of this Act, or as soon thereafter as is
3 practical, the State Treasurer shall transfer and credit to the "87th Session
4 Projects Account" of the "General Improvement Fund", upon certification of
5 the amounts thereof by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the following:

6 (a) all unobligated and unallocated monies remaining in the "General
7 Improvement Fund" on June 30, 2009 which are not required to finance projects
8 to be financed therefrom pursuant to appropriations enacted by the 86th
9 General Assembly, or which have not been reappropriated or reallocated for
10 financing from the "General Improvement Fund" by the 87th General Assembly;

11 (b) any unobligated or unallocated funds remaining on July 2, 2009 in
12 the "General Revenue Allotment Reserve Fund" from monies accruing thereto
13 during the 2007-2009 fiscal biennium which are not required to finance
14 enactments of the 87th General Assembly that do not expire on June 30, 2009;

15 (c) interest earned on State Treasury fund balances as provided in
16 this subsection. For the period commencing on July 1, 2009, and ending June
17 30, 2011, the State Treasurer shall, after complying with provisions of

18 (1) Arkansas Code 27-70-204 for distributing interest income
19 earned from investment of average daily balances of the "State Highway and
20 Transportation Department Fund",

21 (2) Arkansas Code 15-41-110 for distributing interest earned from
22 investment of average daily balances of the "Game Protection Fund", and

23 (3) Arkansas Code 20-78-504 for the next one hundred thousand
24 dollars (\$100,000) of interest income received each fiscal year by the State
25 Treasurer for the "Arkansas Child Care Facilities Loan Guarantee Trust Fund",
26 credit to the "Budget Stabilization Trust Fund" or its successor fund, fifty
27 percent (50%) of the interest income received and credited to the "Securities
28 Reserve Fund", and credit to the "87th Session Projects Account" fifty
29 percent (50%) of the interest income received and credited to the "Securities
30 Reserve Fund" as certified by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, to
31 provide financing to the "87th Session Projects Account", until there has
32 been credited an amount, which when added to the other funds available for
33 such purposes will finance each of the projects or purposes hereinafter
34 enumerated;

35 (d) Those special revenues credited to the General Improvement Fund from
36 estate taxes as set out in Arkansas Code 19-6-301(171);

2 *SECTION 3. Of those moneys accruing to the 87th Session Projects Account*
3 *of the General Improvement Fund as set out in Section 2 of this Act, the*
4 *State Treasurer shall first set-aside \$89,247,860. Such funds set-aside and*
5 *made available under this section shall be used for any project or portion*
6 *thereof enumerated within subsection (a) or (d) so long as the projects*
7 *enumerated in subsection (a)(2) through (a)(9) are fully funded by June 30,*
8 *2011, but not to exceed the amount set out in subsection (a) for the project.*
9 *The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall notify the Arkansas Legislative*
10 *Council of the release of funds for projects enumerated in subsection (a) at*
11 *the same time that the Department of Finance and Administration is notified.*

12 *(a)(1) For transfers, from time to time, to the various fund and fund*
13 *accounts in the Revenue Stabilization Law as amended, or for transfers,*
14 *from time to time, for projects in the Executive Discretionary Division*
15 *(d), upon approval by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget*
16 *Committee, a sum not to exceed forty million dollars (\$40,000,000);*

17 *(2) Department of Correction, for lease payments for Department*
18 *Facilities, \$12,500,000;*

19 *(3) Department of Education - General Education Division, APSCN - for*
20 *Repayment of Loan to Teacher Retirement System, \$5,800,586;*

21 *(4) Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department, for a*
22 *transfer to the State Highway and Transportation Department Fund for*
23 *construction, reconstruction, and improvements of roads, \$10,000,000;*

24 *(5) Arkansas Agriculture Department, for a grant for expenses*
25 *associated with land acquisition, construction, habitat restoration,*
26 *research and maintenance of watershed property around Lake Maumelle in*
27 *order to continue good water quality for the citizens of Central*
28 *Arkansas as well as serving the interests of all the citizens of*
29 *Arkansas in the development of habitat restoration, research and the*
30 *maintenance of such lands \$4,000,000;*

31 *(6) Arkansas Building Authority, for maintenance, renovation,*
32 *equipping, construction, acquisition, improvement, upgrade and*
33 *repair projects for all state-owned real property, \$6,000,000;*

34 *(7) Arkansas Agriculture Department, for the Livestock and Poultry*
35 *Commission for grants for construction and renovation of County and*
36 *District Fairs, \$847,200;*

1 (8) University of Arkansas, for classroom updates, operations, personal
2 services, construction renovations, furnishings, capital outlay,
3 maintenance, equipment and associated costs for the Arkansas School for
4 Mathematics, Sciences and the Arts \$1,000,000;

5 (9) Arkansas Agriculture Department, from funds received from a
6 transfer from the Arkansas Alternative Fuels Development Fund for Dairy
7 Stabilization Program payments, milk production and quality incentives,
8 grants and aid, and maintenance and operating expenses, \$9,100,000.

9
10 (b) Then the Treasurer of State shall first make monthly allocations on the
11 basis of sixty five and four hundred twenty two thousands percent (65.422%)
12 of the total available funds to the Executive Discretionary Division as set
13 out in subsection (d) and the remainder of the total available funds to the
14 Legislative Division listed in subsection (c). The Legislative Division funds
15 shall be used to provide funds to each project enumerated in (c) of this
16 section in proportion that each project's allocation bears to the total of
17 the allocations of all projects enumerated in subsection (c). During the
18 fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the funds made available to the Legislative
19 Division shall be allocated to the various projects enumerated in subsection
20 (c) of this section up to an amount not to exceed 75% of the total funds
21 available for allocation to all projects enumerated subsection (c). The
22 remaining 25% of the funds made available for allocation to the Legislative
23 Division projects enumerated in subsection (c) of this section, or so much
24 thereof as is available, shall be set aside within the Legislative Division
25 of the 87th Session Projects Account and allocated to the Legislative
26 Division projects enumerated in subsection (c) of this section during the
27 fiscal year ending June 30, 2011. Additional funds that may be received by
28 the General Improvement Fund after the projects in subsection (c) have been
29 fully funded shall remain in the General Improvement Fund for such purpose as
30 may be enacted by law, but shall not be a part of the 87th Session Projects
31 Account. Funds made available to the Executive Discretionary Division may be
32 used for any project or portion thereof enumerated within the Executive
33 Discretionary Division but not to exceed the amount set out in subsection (d)
34 for the project. The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall notify the
35 Legislative Council of the Governor's released funds for projects at the same
36 time that the Department of Finance and Administration is notified.

3 (c) Monies reappropriated by the 87th General Assembly for projects for

12 SECTION 7. Distribution of funds for constructing and equipping the

16 of each such radiation therapy institute.

18 SECTION 8. Department of Finance and Administration Disbursing Officer.
19 The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State may distribute funds to the projects in
20 the Legislative Division enumerated under Department of Finance and
21 Administration - Disbursing Officer on a basis other than monthly after prior
22 review of the proposed calendar for disbursements by the Legislative Council.

24 SECTION 9. This Act shall not be incorporated into the Arkansas Code nor
25 published separately as Special, Local and Temporary law.

26

27 SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
28 Assembly that it has considered and enacted appropriations for construction
29 projects and other programs to be financed from the accumulated balances and
30 reserve funds available in the State Treasury; that the total of the enacted
31 appropriations exceed the estimated available funding available for such
32 projects and that the immediate passage of this Act is necessary to establish
33 a method of providing for the orderly financing and a system of priority for
34 the financing of such projects. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist
35 and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public
36 peace, health and safety shall become effective on July 1, 2009.
