18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 1, Chapter 1, Subchapter 1 is amended
21 to add a new section to read as follows:

22 1-1-102. Signature by mark.

23 In addition to the provisions of §§ 4-3-401, 7-5-305, 7-7-308, 27-14-
24 705, and 28-25-103, a signature by mark on a document is legal for the
25 purposes of executing the document if the signature is:

26 (1) Made by a person who at the time of signature lacks the
27 ability to:

28 (A) Write; or

29 (B) Sign his or her name; and

30 (2) Is witnessed by at least one (1) disinterested person.
