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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 14-2-305(a), concerning the Electronic
23 Recording Commission, is amended to read as follows:

24 14-2-305. Administration and standards.

25 (a)(1) An Electronic Recording Commission consisting of nine (9)
26 members appointed by the Governor is created to adopt standards to implement
27 this subchapter.

28 (2) A majority of the members of the commission must be county
29 recorders.

30 (3) A member of the commission shall serve a term of two (2)
31 years.

32 (4) The terms of the current commission members on the effective
33 date of this act shall expire on September 1, 2009.

34 (5) Each member of the commission may receive expense
35 reimbursement in accordance with § 25-16-901 et seq.



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SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 14-20-107(e)(3), concerning the Automated Records Systems Fund Committee, is amended to read as follows:

(3)(A) The Automated Records Systems Fund shall be administered by a committee composed of the county recorders of the counties in Class 6 and Class 7 to be known as the "Automated Records Systems Fund Committee".

(B) The committee shall meet biannually to review grant applications made by county recorders in Class 1 – Class 5 solely for purposes directly related to office automation.

(C) The committee shall not disburse any moneys from the Automated Records Systems Fund to counties in Class 6 and Class 7.

(D) The committee shall expend substantially all of the money from the fund on an annual basis.

(E) Each member of the committee may receive expense reimbursement in accordance with § 25-16-901 et seq.
