9 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL  
10 SERVICES AND OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE  
11 DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION -  
12 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL DIVISION FOR THE  
13 FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2011; AND FOR OTHER  
14 PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

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17 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND  
18 ADMINISTRATION - ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE  
19 CONTROL DIVISION APPROPRIATION FOR THE  
20 2010-2011 FISCAL YEAR.  
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24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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26 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - ABC ADMINISTRATION. There is hereby  
27 established for the Department of Finance and Administration - Alcoholic  
28 Beverage Control Division for the 2010-2011 fiscal year, the following  
29 maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the  
30 provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code  
31 §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.  
32 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual  
33 salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of  
34 said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying  
35 positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the  
36 Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101),

14 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Department of  
 15 Finance and Administration - Alcoholic Beverage Control Division for the  
 16 2010-2011 fiscal year, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary  
 17 employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated  
 18 herein for such purposes: one (1) temporary or part-time employees, when  
 19 needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform  
 20 Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the  
 21 appropriate classification.

23 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - ABC ADMINISTRATION - CASH OPERATIONS. There is  
 24 hereby appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration -  
 25 Alcoholic Beverage Control Division, to be payable from the cash fund  
 26 deposited in the State Treasury as determined by the Chief Fiscal Officer of  
 27 the State, for operating expenses of the Department of Finance and  
 28 Administration - Alcoholic Beverage Control Division for the fiscal year  
 29 ending June 30, 2011, the following:

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5 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - ABC ADMINISTRATION - STATE OPERATIONS. There is

6 hereby appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration -

7 Alcoholic Beverage Control Division, to be payable from the Miscellaneous

8 Agencies Fund Account, for personal services and operating expenses of the

9 Department of Finance and Administration - Alcoholic Beverage Control

10 Division for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the following:

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25 SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized

26 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds

27 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the

28 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and

29 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary

30 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal

31 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by

32 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be

33 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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35 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly

36 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained

1 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
2 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
3 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
4 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
5 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
6 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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8 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
9 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
10 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
11 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2010 is essential to the operation of  
12 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
13 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the  
14 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2010 could work irreparable harm  
15 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
16 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
17 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health  
18 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2010.
