11 YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2013; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

16 APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2012-2013 FISCAL

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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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23 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
24 Arkansas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training for the 2012-
25 2013 fiscal year, the following maximum number of regular employees.

 19 appropriated, to the Arkansas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and
 20 Training, to be payable from the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account, for
 21 personal services and operating expenses of the Arkansas Commission on Law
 22 Enforcement Standards and Training - 911 Training & Education for the fiscal
 23 year ending June 30, 2013, the following:

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1 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
2 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY
3 FORWARD. Any unexpended balances of funds authorized for Capital Outlay in
4 Section 2 of this Act on June 30, ~~2010~~ 2013, shall be carried forward and
5 made available for the same purpose during the fiscal year ending June 30,
6 ~~2011~~ 2014.

7 Any carry forward of unexpended balance of funding as authorized herein, may
8 be carried forward under the following conditions:

9 (1) Prior to June 30, ~~2010~~ 2013, the Agency shall by written statement set
10 forth its reason(s) for the need to carry forward said funding to the
11 Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget;

12 (2) The Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget shall
13 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council all amounts carried forward from
14 the first fiscal year of the biennium to the second fiscal year of the
15 biennium by the September Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget
16 Committee meeting in the second fiscal year of the biennial period which
17 report shall include the name of the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution
18 and the amount of funding carried forward from the first fiscal year to the
19 second fiscal year, the program name or line item, the funding source and a
20 copy of the written request set forth in (1) above;

21 (3) Each Agency, Board, Commission or Institution shall provide a written
22 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee
23 containing all information set forth in item (2) above, along with a written
24 statement as to the current status of the project, contract, purpose etc. for
25 which the carry forward was originally requested no later than thirty (30)
26 days prior to the time the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution presents
27 its budget request to the Arkansas Legislative Council/Joint Budget
28 Committee; and

29 (4) Thereupon, the Department of Finance and Administration shall include
30 all information obtained in item (3) above in the budget manuals and/or a
31 statement of non-compliance by the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution.
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33 SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
34 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
35 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
36 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and

1 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
2 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
3 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
4 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
5 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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7 SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
8 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
9 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
10 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
11 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
12 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
13 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
14 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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16 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
17 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
18 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
19 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2012 is essential to the operation of
20 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
21 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
22 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2012 could work irreparable harm
23 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
24 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
25 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
26 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2012.
