## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING THE APPOINTMENT  
10 AND COMMISSION OF A NOTARY PUBLIC; TO ALLOW A  
11 NONRESIDENT SPOUSE OF A UNITED STATES MILITARY  
12 SERVICE MEMBER TO BE A NOTARY PUBLIC; AND FOR OTHER  
13 PURPOSES.

17 TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING THE  
18 APPOINTMENT AND COMMISSION OF A NOTARY  
19 PUBLIC; AND TO ALLOW A NONRESIDENT SPOUSE  
20 OF A UNITED STATES MILITARY SERVICE  
21 MEMBER TO BE A NOTARY PUBLIC.

24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
25

26 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 21-14-101(b), concerning the appointment  
27 and commission of a notary public, is amended to read as follows:

28 (b) Every applicant for appointment and commission as a notary public  
29 shall complete an application to be filed with the Secretary of State  
30 stating:

31 (1) That he or she is:

32 (A) ~~Either a~~ One (1) of the following:

33 (i) ~~Bona~~ A bona fide citizen of the United States;  
34 ~~or~~

35 (ii) ~~Permanent~~ A permanent resident alien who shall  
36 file with his or her application a recorded Declaration of Domicile;



1                   ~~(B)~~(iii) A legal resident of Arkansas;  
 2                   (iv) ~~or an~~ A legal resident of an adjoining state  
 3 and employed or operating a business in the State of Arkansas; or

4                   (v)(a) Nonresident spouse of a United States  
 5 military service member employed or operating a business in Arkansas;

6                   (b) One (1) copy of a United States Department  
 7 of Defense DD Form 1173 or a United States Department of Defense DD Form  
 8 1173-1, otherwise known as a Uniformed Services Identification and Privilege  
 9 Card, shall be included with his or her application under this subsection;

10                   ~~(C)~~(B) Eighteen (18) years of age or older; and

11                   ~~(D)~~(C) Able to read and write English;

12                   (2) The address of his or her place of employment, business, or  
 13 residence in this state;

14                   (3) That during the past ten (10) years, his or her commission  
 15 as a notary public has not been revoked; and

16                   (4) That he or she has not been convicted of a felony.

17  
 18                   SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 21-14-101(e), concerning the appointment  
 19 and commission of a notary public, is amended to read as follows:

20                   (e) Every notary public shall file in the office of the recorder of  
 21 deeds for the county where the notary public resides or in the case of a  
 22 resident of an adjoining state or nonresident spouse of a United States  
 23 military service member, in the county in Arkansas ~~where employed~~ of his or  
 24 her place of employment or business, either:

25                   (1) A surety bond executed by a surety insurer authorized to do  
 26 business in Arkansas to the state for the faithful discharge of the notary  
 27 public's duties in the sum of seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$7,500),  
 28 to be approved by the Secretary of State; or

29                   (2) A surety contract guaranteeing the notary public's faithful  
 30 discharge of his or her duties executed to the State of Arkansas for not more  
 31 than an aggregate seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$7,500), issued by a  
 32 general business corporation validly organized and formed under the laws of  
 33 this state pertaining to domestic corporations and which:

34                   (A) Has previously registered with the Insurance  
 35 Commissioner on forms prescribed by the commissioner evidencing the  
 36 corporation's purpose to issue only surety contracts for notaries public

1 pursuant to the provisions of this section;

2 (B) Has previously deposited and thereafter maintains with  
 3 the commissioner securities in the sum of not less than ten thousand dollars  
 4 (\$10,000) executed to the State of Arkansas that are issued by a  
 5 nonaffiliated corporate entity and are approved by the commissioner; and

6 (C) Is not otherwise transacting any insurance business in  
 7 this state that requires compliance with the provisions of the Arkansas  
 8 Insurance Code.

9  
 10 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 21-14-101(g)(1), concerning the appointment  
 11 and commission of a notary public, is amended to read as follows:

12 (g)(1) Every notary public shall sign the following declaration in the  
 13 presence of the circuit clerk for the county where the notary public resides  
 14 or if a resident of another state or a nonresident spouse of a United States  
 15 military service member, the circuit clerk for the county in Arkansas ~~where~~  
 16 employed of his or her place of employment or business:

17 “I, (name of notary), solemnly swear or affirm that I have carefully read the  
 18 notary laws of this state, and I will uphold the Constitutions of the United  
 19 States and the State of Arkansas and will faithfully perform to the best of  
 20 my ability all notarial acts in accordance with the law. (Signature of  
 21 notary) \_\_\_\_\_

22 Subscribed and sworn to before me (name of circuit clerk), Circuit Clerk for  
 23 the County of (name of county), State of Arkansas, on this \_\_\_\_\_ day of

27 SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 21-14-102 is amended to read as follows:

28 21-14-102. Change of residence.

29 (a)(1) Upon receiving notification of a change of residency, the  
 30 Secretary of State shall transfer a notary public’s appointment and  
 31 commission to the new county of residence in instances in which a person  
 32 appointed and commissioned a notary public under § 21-14-101 changes  
 33 residence to a county within this state other than the county where the  
 34 notary public resided on the date of commission.

35 (2) Upon receiving notification of a change in place of  
 36 employment, the Secretary of State shall transfer a notary public’s

1 appointment and commission to the new county of employment in the case of a  
2 resident of an adjoining state or a nonresident spouse of a United States  
3 military service member changing his or her place of employment to a county  
4 within this state other than the county where the notary public was employed  
5 on the date of commission.

6 (b) The original bond or certified copy of the original bond from the  
7 original county of residence shall also be filed by the notary public in the  
8 new county of residence or if the notary public is a resident of an adjoining  
9 state or a nonresident spouse of a United States military service member, in  
10 the new county of employment in Arkansas.
