8 AN ACT TO REAPPROPRIATE THE BALANCES OF CAPITAL
9 IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE SECRETARY OF
10 STATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

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13 AN ACT FOR THE SECRETARY OF STATE
14 REAPPROPRIATION.
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18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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20 SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS. There is
21 hereby appropriated, to the Secretary of State, to be payable from the
22 Development and Enhancement Fund, for the Secretary of State the following:

23 (A) Effective July 1, 2020, the balance of the appropriation provided
24 in Item (K) of Section 1 of Act 268 of 2019, for construction, site
25 preparation and maintenance of the Arkansas Fallen Firefighters' Memorial on
26 the State Capitol Grounds or for upkeep, maintenance, preservation and repair
27 of all Monuments and Memorials on the grounds of the State Capitol, in a sum
28 not to exceed\$19,789.

29 (B) Effective July 1, 2020, the balance of the appropriation provided
30 in Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 362 of 2019, for replacement of voting
31 machine equipment - statewide, in a sum not to exceed\$15,000,000.

32 (C) Effective July 1, 2020, the balance of the appropriation provided
33 in Item (B) of Section 1 of Act 362 of 2019, for HVAC upgrade to North End of
34 State Capitol building, in a sum not to exceed\$6,500,000.

35 (D) Effective July 1, 2020, the balance of the appropriation provided
36 in Item (C) of Section 1 of Act 362 of 2019, for roof and window repair of



1 the State Capitol building, in a sum not to exceed\$2,500,000.

2 (E) Effective July 1, 2020, the balance of the appropriation provided
3 in Item (D) of Section 1 of Act 362 of 2019, for asphalt resurfacing,
4 replacement of damaged sidewalks and curbs, addition of lighting to unlit or
5 dark areas, an upgrade of the irrigation system, and landscaping and
6 plantings for the North Entry Promenade I & II of the State Capitol Grounds,
7 in a sum not to exceed\$538,112.

8 (F) Effective July 1, 2020, the balance of the appropriation provided
9 in Item (E) of Section 1 of Act 362 of 2019, for drains and storm water
10 system renovations of the State Capitol Grounds, in a sum not to exceed
11\$483,000.

12 (G) Effective July 1, 2020, the balance of the appropriation provided
13 in Item (F) of Section 1 of Act 362 of 2019, for interior plumbing and sump
14 pump replacement for the State Capitol building, in a sum not to exceed
15\$108,393.

16 (H) Effective July 1, 2020, the balance of the appropriation provided
17 in Item (G) of Section 1 of Act 362 of 2019, for electrical panel replacement
18 in the State Capitol building, in a sum not to exceed\$212,980.

19 (I) Effective July 1, 2020, the balance of the appropriation provided
20 in Item (H) of Section 1 of Act 362 of 2019, for expenses for State Capitol
21 as-built drawings, in a sum not to exceed\$250,000.

22 (J) Effective July 1, 2020, the balance of the appropriation provided
23 in Item (I) of Section 1 of Act 362 of 2019, for "Green" Initiatives for the
24 State Capitol building, facilities and grounds including ventilation system
25 cleaning, energy efficiency improvements and assessment, analysis and
26 consulting services, recycling programs and/or related construction,
27 renovation and equipping of and/or conversion to or purchase of Compressed
28 Natural Gas vehicles and equipment including installation of a refueling
29 station, in a sum not to exceed\$1,500,000.

30 (K) Effective July 1, 2020, the balance of the appropriation provided
31 in Item (J) of Section 1 of Act 362 of 2019, for stone restoration, cleaning
32 and repointing on the East Side of the State Capitol building, in a sum not
33 to exceed\$3,500,000.
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35 SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION - NCRC GRANT. There is hereby appropriated,
36 to the Secretary of State, to be payable from the Arkansas Natural and

1 Cultural Resources Grant and Trust Fund, for the Secretary of State the
2 following:

3 (A) Effective July 1, 2020, the balance of the appropriation provided
4 in Section 25 of Act 902 of 2019, for acquisition, management, stewardship or
5 preservation of state owned lands, historic sites, buildings, structures or
6 objects, in a sum not to exceed\$823,729.
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8 SECTION 3. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor
9 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects
10 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available
11 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and
12 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and
13 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or
14 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
15 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects
16 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
17 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
18 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall
19 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

20 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State
21 Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the
22 Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of
23 this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and
24 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in
25 disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided
26 otherwise by law.
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28 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
29 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
30 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
31 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
32 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
33 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
34 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
35 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
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1 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
2 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
3 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
4 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2020 is essential to the operation of
5 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
6 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
7 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2020 could work irreparable harm
8 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
9 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
10 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
11 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2020.
