

## HOUSE AMENDMENT 1 TO hb1288.

deleting subsections (b), (c) and (d) on lines 26 through 36 of page 1 and on lines 1 through 17 of page 2 and substituting therefor the following:

"(b) Beginning with the ~~1994-95~~ 1998-1999 school year, all school districts ~~should~~ shall have no less than one (1) full-time school nurse per one thousand (1,000) students.

(c) In districts having a high concentration of children with disabling conditions as determined by the State Board of Education, the ratio of school nurses to students ~~should~~ shall be one (1) full-time nurse to four hundred (400) students in those schools so designated.

(d) In a district which provides a center for profoundly disabled students, the ratio ~~should~~ shall be one (1) full-time school nurse per one hundred twenty-five (125) students ~~at that center~~.

(e) School nurses may be employed or provided by contract or agreement with other agencies or individuals provided that the prescribed ratio and equivalency are maintained. Provided, however, no school nurse may be employed by, or contract with, any public secondary or elementary school of this state except with the prior approval of the local school board.

(f) For purposes of this section, a school nurse shall mean ~~the equivalent of a~~ licensed nurse engaging in school nursing activities.""
