

## HOUSE AMENDMENT 1 TO hb1620.

deleting lines 9 through 12 on page 1 and substituting therefor:

"\_AN ACT TO PROHIBIT PERSONS CONVICTED FOR CERTAIN SERIOUS OFFENSES FROM PARTICIPATING IN ANY MERITORIOUS FURLOUGH PROGRAM BY OR FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.\_"

AND

by deleting lines 15 through 19 on page 1 and substituting therefor:

"\_AN ACT TO PROHIBIT PERSONS CONVICTED FOR CERTAIN SERIOUS OFFENSES FROM PARTICIPATING IN ANY MERITORIOUS FURLOUGH PROGRAM BY OR FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION.\_"

AND

by deleting lines 23 through 36 on page 1 and lines 1 through 4 on page 2 and substituting therefor the following:

"SECTION 1. A person who is convicted for any of the following offenses shall be ineligible to participate in any meritorious furlough program conducted by or for the Department of Correction:

(1) Capital murder, Arkansas Code 5-10-101;

(2) Kidnapping, Arkansas Code 5-11-102;

(3) Rape, Arkansas Code 5-14-103;

(4) Any other offense under Arkansas Code Title 5, Chapter 14, Subchapter 1, concerning sexual offenses;

(5) An offense concerning sexual exploitation of children, Arkansas Code 5-27-301 et seq.;

(6) An offense concerning use of children in sexual performances, Arkansas Code 5-27-401 et seq.; or

(7) Stalking, Arkansas Code 5-71-229."
