

HOUSE AMENDMENT 1 TO hb1633.

deleting on line 26 of page 2 the words "for compensation";

AND

by deleting on line 35 of page 2 the word "nutritionist" and substituting the following:
"psychologist, psychological examiner, licensed professional counselor, dietician, dental hygienist";

AND

by deleting on line 18 of page 3 the word "and";

AND

by deleting on line 20 of page 3 the period (.) and substituting a semicolon (,);

AND

by inserting on line 21 of page 3 new subdivisions to read as follows:

"(7) Any occupational safety and health professional, such as an industrial hygienist, providing that such persons do not hold themselves out under the title of certified health education specialist, certified professional health educator, or health educator, unless so certified; and

(8) Employees who work under the guidance of a licensed physician, providing that such persons do not hold themselves out under the title of certified health education specialist, certified professional health educator, or health educator, unless so certified."

AND

by deleting the period (.) at the end of line 28 of page 3 and substituting the following:
", provided that such persons do not hold themselves out under the title of certified health education specialist, certified professional health educator, or health educator, unless so certified.

(d) Community volunteers may conduct health education related activities, provided that such persons do not hold themselves out under the title of certified health education specialist, certified professional health educator, or health educator unless so certified.

(e) When invited by school officials, parents or volunteers may conduct health education related activities in private or public school classrooms or assemblies, provided that such persons do not hold themselves out under the title of certified health education specialist, certified professional health educator or health educator unless so certified.

(f) This act is not intended to apply to other professional boards and associations and their continuing education efforts."

AND

by inserting on line 1 of page 6 between the word "requirements" and the word "as" the

language "consistent with those of the National Commission for Health Education
credentialing";

AND

by inserting on line 19 of page 6 a new subsection to read as follows:

"(2) provides evidence of having earned a degree from a U. S. college or university
that was accredited at the time the degree was conferred;";

AND

by appropriately renumbering subsequent subsections of Section 10;

AND

by deleting line 22 of page 6 and substituting the following:

"(3) passes an examination within two (2) years."
