

HOUSE AMENDMENT 1 TO hb1706.

overstriking on line 15 of page 2 the semicolon (;) at the end of the line and inserting after the semicolon (;) a period "_" and a new subdivision (a)(1)(B)(iii) as follows:

"(iii) As a condition of awarding the temporary annuity for members retiring under § 24-10-607, the board shall require the disabled member to file any and all appropriate forms and pleadings with the Social Security Administration, and pursue through the administrative process a disability determination. The board shall condition the payment of the temporary annuity that, in the event the disabled member is awarded disability benefits under the federal Social Security Act, the temporary annuity shall terminate and that the member shall reimburse the system an amount equal to the after-tax benefits received from social security for the period the member has received the temporary annuity. Provided, that the amount of any reimbursement shall not exceed the total amount of the actual payments received by the member prior to the award of the social security disability benefits.";

AND

by inserting on line 12 of page 3 after the period (.) a new subdivision (a)(2)(C)(iii) as follows:

"(iii) As a condition of awarding the temporary annuity for members retiring under § 24-10-607, the board shall require the disabled member to file any and all appropriate forms and pleadings with the Social Security Administration, and pursue through the administrative process a disability determination. The board shall condition the payment of the temporary annuity that, in the event the disabled member is awarded disability benefits under the federal Social Security Act, the temporary annuity shall terminate and that the member shall reimburse the system an amount equal to the after-tax benefits received from social security for the period the member has received the temporary annuity. Provided, that the amount of any reimbursement shall not exceed the total amount of the actual payments received by the member prior to the award of the social security disability benefits."
