"SECTION 94. SPECIAL LANGUAGE - MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES - GEORGE W. JACKSON COMMUNITY MENTAL HEALTH CENTER. If during either year of the biennial period ending June 30, 1999, the current state operated Community Mental Health Center (George W. Jackson, Community Mental Health Center, Jonesboro) acquires private non-profit status, the Department of Human Services shall reallocate or transfer funds to the private non-profit entity to ensure the continued delivery of satisfactory levels of service. The funds to be reallocated or transferred will be an amount equal to the general revenue - operations funding allocated to George W. Jackson, Community Mental Health Center during State fiscal year ending June 30, 1997. Further, after acquiring private non-profit status, George W. Jackson Community Mental Health Center shall continue to utilize existing buildings and

equipment.".

and

by inserting the following new sections immediately following Section 99:

"SECTION 100. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Human Services, Division of Developmental Disabilities Services, to be payable from the cash funds of the Department of Human Services, Division of Developmental Disabilities Services for capital improvements to the physical plant and for the purchase of capital equipment for the six human development centers operated by the Department of Human Services, Division of Developmental Services. The cash funds shall be held by the Department of Human Services, Division of Developmental Disabilities Services from the proceeds of the sale of timber that may be harvested from land owned by the Division of Developmental Disabilities Services. The harvesting of timber is specifically authorized to provide funds to finance capital improvements to the physical plants and for major capital equipment purchases at any of the six human development centers.

The Division of Developmental Disabilities Services shall report all income derived from timber management to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and the Arkansas Legislative Council. Any contracts initiated for the harvesting of timber shall be submitted to the Review Subcommittee of the Arkansas Legislative Council for review. All expenditures of funds derived from the sale of timber will be expended in accordance with relevant state purchasing laws.

SECTION 101. Arkansas Code 11-10-509(a) is amended to read as follows:

_(a) With respect to service performed in an instructional, research, or principal administrative capacity for an educational institution, or for a community program licensed by the Division of Developmental Disabilities Services, benefits shall not be paid based on services for any week of unemployment commencing during the period between two (2) successive academic years or terms, during a similar period between two (2) regular but not successive terms, or during a period of paid sabbatical leave provided for in the individual's contract, to any individual if the individual performs the services in the first of the academic years or terms and if there is a contract or a reasonable assurance that the individual will perform services in any such capacity for any educational institution in the second of the academic years or terms.";
