"(a) The Treasurer of State shall first make monthly allocations in the proportions set out in this subsection to the funds and fund accounts listed below until there has been transferred a total of two billion eight hundred fifty five million one hundred eighty one thousand eight hundred forty nine dollars (\$ 2,855,181,849) or so much thereof as may become available; provided, that the Treasurer of State shall make such monthly allocations in accordance with each fund or fund account's proportionate part of the total of
