

HOUSE AMENDMENT 1 TO hb1884.

deleting line 5 on page 1 and substituting therefor the following:

"By: Representatives Wagner, Capps, Madison, McJunkin, Cunningham, Young, and Broadway"

and

by deleting "subsections (b) and (c)" from line 23 on page 1 and substituting therefor:
"subsection (b)"

and

by deleting lines 30 and 31 on page 1

and

by deleting "(c)" from line 32 on page 1 and substituting therefor: "(b)"

and

by inserting an additional sentence between the period and the quotation mark at the end of line 35 on page 1 to read as follows:

"It is not the intent of this subsection to eliminate the requirement that motor vehicles be inspected annually nor to eliminate the penalties for failure to maintain current inspection stickers on motor vehicles."

and

by inserting two additional sections immediately following Section 3 to read as follows:

"SECTION 4. The Director of the Department of Finance and Administration may utilize monies appropriated for miscellaneous tax refunds as a revenue source for the purchase of bonds or other evidences of indebtedness secured by the motor vehicle inspection fees.

SECTION 5. The Department of Finance and Administration shall establish a system whereby, through the use of a central computerized data base or computer network, the motor vehicle registration offices may access by computer the status of property tax assessments of motor vehicles and whether property taxes are delinquent on motor vehicles. Participation in the system shall be at the option of each county. The Department of Finance and Administration shall provide assistance, including any available financial assistance to counties which opt to participate."

and

by appropriately renumbering the subsequent sections
