

SENATE AMENDMENT 1 TO hb1946.

adding the following new section on line 2 of page 11:

"SECTION 14. In addition to the post exchange and other post operations authorized to be taken over by the Arkansas Military Department pursuant to the provisions of this act, the Adjutant General is given further authority to take over operation of all military service clubs on Fort Chaffee. It is recognized that Fort Chaffee has operated under exclusive federal jurisdiction and such military service clubs have not been required to obtain a license from the State of Arkansas to authorize such operations. However, pursuant to resumption of State jurisdiction over Fort Chaffee, state licenses will be required. Therefore, there is hereby created a Military Service Club mixed drink permit to be issued to service clubs on military reservations owned or controlled by the State of Arkansas. The Arkansas Alcoholic Beverage Control Division is authorized to issue such permits to each military service club operating on Fort Chaffee. The annual fee for each such permit shall be five hundred dollars (\$500) and such fees shall be due and collected in the same manner as all other permit fees collected by the Alcoholic Beverage Control Division. Food service requirements for restaurants, as set out in Arkansas Code Annotated § 3-9-202, et seq., shall no be applicable. Hours of operation for such service clubs shall be the same as are now in existence for private clubs licensed pursuant to Arkansas Code Annotated § 3-9-221, et seq. The Arkansas Alcoholic Beverage Control Division is authorized to adopt reasonable rules and regulations to provide for the operation of such service clubs consistent with the intent and purposes of this act."
