

## HOUSE AMENDMENT 1 TO sb394.

inserting on line 6 of page 1 a new House sponsor line as follows: "By: Representatives D. Hudson and Molinaro";

AND

by inserting in the Title on line 11 of page 1 between the semicolon (;) and the word "AND" the new language "TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY;";

AND

by inserting on line 18 of page 2 a new SECTION 5. as follows:

"SECTION 5. Emergency. It is hereby found and determined by the Eighty-First General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that advertising and promotion commission members should represent as large as cross-section of the community as possible; that the law restricts somewhat the capacity of persons to serve; and that it is immediately necessary for this process to be opened up to other persons. Therefore, in order to broaden community representation, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on the date of its approval by the Governor. If the bill is neither approved or vetoed by the Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides the veto."
