

SENATE AMENDMENT 1 TO sb607.

deleting "two (2)" from line 23 on page 1 and substituting "three (3)"

AND

by deleting "one (1) shall be a" from line 24 on page 1

AND

by deleting line 25 on page 1 and substituting "and four (4) shall be"

AND

by deleting line 30 on page 1 and substituting "the committee no later than June 1, 1997."

AND

by inserting "providers of" on line 13 on page 3 between "all" and "local"

AND

by deleting "carriers" from line 14 on page 3 and substituting "service"

AND

by inserting "providers of" on line 19 on page 3 between "the" and "local"

AND

by deleting "carriers" from line 20 on page 3 and substituting "service"

AND

by inserting an additional section following Section 13 to read as follows:

"SECTION 14. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the General Assembly that the deaf and hearing impaired citizens of this state have inadequate access to telecommunications services; that this act will enhance the delivery of telecommunications services to the deaf and hearing impaired citizens of this state, and that this act should

go into effect as soon as possible. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall become effective on the date of its approval by the Governor. If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides the veto."
