**Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 1012.**

Amend House Bill No. 1012 as originally introduced:

Add Representatives Altes, Bond, Bradford, Creekmore, Fite, Glover, Hausam, Lowery, Minton, Rackley, Rodgers, Stovall, Taylor, Willis, Scroggin, Files, and Bright as cosponsors of the bill

AND

Add Senator Hunter as a cosponsor of the bill

AND

Page 1, delete lines 19 through 22, and substitute the following:

"SECTION 1. (a) If, after the effective date of this act, a person pleads guilty or nolo contendere to, or is found guilty of, a felony for an offense that was committed during the person's term of elective office and in the person's official capacity and the plea or finding occurred in a court of record of this state or a federal court and the plea or finding occurred during that same term of office, and all state and federal appeals have been exhausted, the elected official shall be deemed to have forfeited."

AND

Page 1, delete lines 24 and 25, and substitute the following:

"(2) Publicly-funded retirement benefits based on service during the term of office during which the offense was committed."
