AND

Page 2, delete lines 29 and 30 and substitute: "<u>savings account an amount that does not exceed the deductible amount of</u> a gualified higher deductible health plan."

Page 2, line 32, delete "<u>three thousand dollars (\$3,000)</u>" and substitute "<u>the</u> <u>amount of the deductible</u>"

AND

Page 2, line 36, delete "<u>three thousand</u>" and substitute "<u>the amount of the</u> <u>deductible.</u>"

AND

Page 3, delete lines 13 through 15 and substitute: "(e)(1) Documentation of eligible medical expenses paid during the tax year shall be submitted to the account administrator, and the account administrator shall reimburse the expenses."

Page 3, line 27, delete "<u>section</u>" and substitute "<u>section unless the balance</u> <u>is rolled over into another medical savings account within sixty (60) calendar</u> <u>days</u>"

AND

Page 3, line 29, delete "<u>plan</u>" and substitute "<u>plan unless the account holder</u> is covered by a health plan during any period of continuation coverage required by federal or state law or if the account holder is unemployed"
