Subtitle of House Bill No. 1024

"TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 5-73-306 TO PERMIT A PERSON TO CARRY A
CONCEALED HANDGUN INTO A RESTAURANT OR PUBLIC PARK."

Amendment No. 2 to House Bill No. 1024.

Amend House Bill No. 1024 as engrossed, H1/17/01:

Page 1, line 23, delete "5-73-306(a) is" and substitute "5-73-306(a) and (b) are"

AND

Page 2, line 28, insert an additional subsection to read as follows:

"(b)(1) In addition to the places enumerated in this section, the carrying of a concealed handgun may be disallowed in any place in the discretion of the person or entity exercising control over the physical location of such place by the placing of a written notice at each roadway entrance to such location. Should such location not have a roadway entrance, a written notice may be placed anywhere upon the premises except that there must be at least one (1) written notice posted within every three (3) acres of a location with no roadway entrance.

(2) The written notice must be clearly readable at a distance of not less than ten feet (10') that the "carrying of a handgun is prohibited".

(2)(3) Provided, no sign shall be required for private homes, and any licensee entering a private home shall notify the occupants that he is carrying a concealed handgun."
